

Darlington Trail



The Darlington Trail is marked with yellow trail markers and is located on Township-owned open space. Take Rt I South past Wawa Dairies and turn right on Darlington Rd just past the Arts Center. It is most easily accessible from the parking lot on Darlington Road. The trail follows Chester Creek for several hundred yards then parallels an old railroad right-of-way. It then crosses portions of the former Darlington Family Dairy through mixed woods, meadows and farmland, thence to return via Darlington Road, or alternatively, to continue on a similar perimeter trail around the portion of the farm north of Darlington Road featuring woodlands, old farmsteads, and meadows exhibiting the presence of the invasive multiflora rose. The entire loop is approximately 2-3/4 miles and the terrain is varied, offering some flat areas and some steeper sections that create exceptional vistas of the rolling Chester Creek Valley.
